2024-2025 REENROLLMENT: Reenrollment is open through Friday, March 22! Please log into the <u>FACTS Family Portal</u>, click **Apply/Enroll** in the menu, then **Enrollment/Reenrollment** to find the online packets. Each parent will also need to complete a <u>background check</u> to volunteer next year, incoming Kindergarteners need to turn in a birth certificate and vaccine record, and all preschoolers need to turn in <u>health appraisals</u> and vaccine records. And, if your PK to 4th grader needs before/after school care, <u>fill out an extended care contract</u> and turn in with your reenrollment packet.

ILLNESS - WHEN TO KEEP YOUR STUDENT HOME

Please review the school's sick policy, so we can make sure we are doing our best to keep everyone safe and healthy. If you are unsure or have questions, contact the office.

While we encourage students to attend school every day, an ill child will not perform well and may expose other students in the classroom. The school will send students home if any of the following symptoms are present. It is also expected that you will keep your child at home if any of these symptoms are present:

-fever of 100 degrees or greater (before medication)
-an undiagnosed rash
headache

-any known communicable disease -persistent or severe

- -an earache or draining ear
- -severe sore throat
- -persistent and severe cough

- -diarrhea or vomiting
- -evidence of head lice

If your child has a fever of 100 degrees or greater, they must be fever free without medication for 24 hours before returning to school. A child also needs to be free of diarrhea for 24 hours to return to school.
